From June through early August while our Club kids are out of school and attending our summer programming, we continue to provide educational development and high yield learning activities, including tutoring where needed, through our Power Ahead summer program. This allows kids to keep what they learned during the previous school year, fresh in their minds. It also helps teachers at the beginning of the new upcoming school year transition from the previous curriculum to the next grade level curriculum.

How many lives have been impacted over the last quarter? Club unduplicated youth impacted over the last quarter including the summer and beginning of the FY23 school year are 183!

Over 65% of those youth come from single parent homes or are reared by grandparents. 93% of our kids are of African American descent or of two or more races. Seven percent are Caucasian. A large percentage of these youth and their families live at or below the poverty line.
