Survivor Resource Center outputs and goals for the funding period were to provide programs to 6,000 participants.

How many lives have been impacted over the last quarter?

The funding through the United Way enabled us to provide a total of 38 evidence based, age-appropriate prevention education programs in Vermilion County Schools this quarter, impacting the lives of **564** students. The programs were aimed at preventing bullying, sexual harassment and abuse, and physical fighting. In addition, professional training programs were provided **36** educators and social service providers. This included a full day trauma informed care training to Project Success staff.

The demographics of the students vary widely as schools have students that span a wide variety of socio-economic and cultural background. The demographics are not gathered by us when we conduct programs. We will assess ways to compile demographic data from the schools that we provide programs to.

We surpassed our goals for the funded year, providing prevention education programs to **7,400** participants in schools, after school and summer programs.

We have received very positive feedback from participants and staff at the programs provided to the Boys and Girls Club. In addition to prevention education programs, we conducted a joint community event with them for a neighborhood gathering at Garfield park that provided a fun safe environment for the community members and provided information on violence prevention efforts. We are continuing to partner with them throughout the year.
